Team structures

The events, divisions and age categories for Football at OMGAD2026 are as follows:

For each team to be confirmed, a minimum of 14 athletes need to be registered. The age of the youngest registered team member determines which age category the team will compete in and for the Games, your age is determined as of 31 December 2026. Each athlete can only enter to compete in one team.

There is no maximum number of players per team, although prior to each match, each team is only permitted to name a maximum of 18 players (11 selected players and up to seven substitutes) on the official Start List for each match.

For each team to be confirmed, a minimum of 10 athletes need to be registered. The age of the youngest registered team member determines which age category the team will compete in and for the Games, your age is determined as of 31 December 2026. Each athlete can only enter to compete in one team.

There is no maximum number of players per team, although prior to each match, each team is only permitted to name a maximum of 12 players (7 selected players and up to five substitutes) on the official Start List for each match.

The following grade definitions have been determined for Open Master Games Abu Dhabi 2026 Football competition:

- **Competitive**: Teams that have three or more senior players with international, national or state representative open experience. Teams without international, national and state representatives are still encouraged to enter into the Premier Grade but should expect matches of a very competitive nature.
- **Recreational**: Open to everyone, including teams/individuals that participate or have participated, at a local competition level.

The Open Masters Games Football Organising Committee reserves the right to move teams between grades.

Competition format

The following format for play has been identified for the Open Masters Games Football competition:

UNITED BY SPORTS, ACTIVE FOR LIFE

- a) There will be a round robin tournament, with finals and playoff matches to determine final placings. Where sufficient entries are received, teams will be split into pools for preliminary rounds.
- b) Based on proposed competition format, each team can expect to play a minimum of five games and if finishing in the top four of their pool, will then play playoffs for medals.
- c) Final draw format will be determined once number of teams are confirmed. In order to produce a viable draw some grades and ages will be combined at the discretion of the Open Master Games Abu Dhabi 2026 Football Organising Committee.
- d) All pool matches, semi-final and final matches will consist of 30 minute halves with a five minute break at half time. All matches requiring a winner will proceed directly to kicks from the penalty spot.

Technical Meeting

One representative from each team is expected to attend the Football Technical Meeting prior to the commencement of the event. Further information will be confirmed closer to the start of the competition.

Technical delegate

The Technical Delegate endorsed by FIBA will be announced in Version 2 of the Guide. The Technical Delegate will oversee the implementation of all sport specific rules and requirements at the Games.
